

OFFICIAL CONFERENCE DRESS CODE FOR SKILLSUSA IDAHO

1. Opening ceremony:

Appropriate contest attire if in a leadership contest, or business professional (white shirt/blouse, black pants/skirt, closed toe/back shoes, no athletic shoes) if not in a leadership contest. A suit & tie are optional except for state officers, who must be in official attire.

2. Leadership and Skills contests:

Appropriate contest attire, including safety equipment. Follow the contest attire matrix on the SkillsUSA Idaho Web page.

3. Official, but non-contest SkillsUSA events. Example: Friday night free time:

Business casual (collared shirt, no inappropriate pictures or slogans, slacks, one T-shirt is allowed - SkillsUSA Idaho T-shirts).

4. Closing ceremony

Appropriate contest attire for pictures, or business professional (white shirt/blouse, black pants/skirt, closed toed shoes). A suit & tie are optional except for state officers, who must be in official attire. If students are wearing jeans, they will not be allowed to walk on stage at the Awards Ceremony.
